Dear Participants of IAUGA2022,

Here are some last minute tips.

- 1. Assuming you have a "Q-code" & an appointment at the COVID19 testing centers at ICN (note that the testing centers at T1 terminal open for 24h),
 - entry procedures (taxing + quarantine + immigration): ~1 hour (depending on the no. of landing flights)
 - baggage claim: ~0.5 hour
 - COVID19 test: ~0.5 hour
 - buying tickets for AREX and finding AREX platform inside T2 or T1: ~0.3 hour
 - AREX ride itself from ICN to Seoul station: ~1-1.2 hour

Expected arrival time at Seoul station = arrival time of your flight + 3.5 hour --> This is only a guide for when to reserve your KTX train.

(For my three trips in April-June without checked baggage, without COVID testing, with a Korean passport, it took me 2 - 2.5 hours.)

3. If you miss your train,

- -You can get a partial refund at the ticket windows of Seoul station.
- -If seats are sold out for the next trains, you may have to wait for 1-2 hours to buy the next available tickets.
- -The last train for Busan leaves at 22:30.
- -If no seats are available on the day, you should stay overnight at a hotel nearby.

There are reasonable hotels near Seoul Station.

- 1. Four Points by Sheraton Josun, Seoul Station
- 2. Courtyard by Marriott Seoul Namdaemun
- 3. Hotel President

4. Making an appointment for COVID-19 tests at ICN

- There will a separate line for people with online appointment.
- If you arrive at the testing center earlier than your appointment,
 - they will let you go ahead and take the test upon your arrival.

- Main advantage is that you save time by putting your information online in advance, so onsite waiting is shorter.
